

# **CHECKLIST FOR A COMPLETE APPLICATION**

## **Fulbright-Hays DDRA application 2010-11**

**DEADLINE: Noon, Friday, November 13, 2009**

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**A COMPLETE APPLICATION consists of parts I, II, and III below; no exceptions are made to the campus deadline.**

**I. Electronic Application materials must be submitted by the campus deadline.** This includes ALL letters of recommendation, language evaluations, and letters of affiliation.

**II. One original hard copy is due in 328 Ingraham Hall by the campus deadline:**

- Application Forms
- Budget
- Curriculum Vitae
- Proposal (10 pages) + bibliography (2 pages)
- Official transcripts for all **GRADUATE WORK**. You are to collect and submit transcripts together with application materials.
- **Attachment A:** Applicant's authorization for UW to release information, dated and signed, available at .
- **Letters of affiliation (if you have them) must be uploaded and submitted with your electronic application**

**III. One Word document sent as email attachment of your human subjects narrative** (see Campus Instructions) to [fellow@intl-institute.wisc.edu](mailto:fellow@intl-institute.wisc.edu). You do not have to go through IRB at this time. You prepare the narrative to the best of your ability, using the guidelines in the e-application instructions.

**\*\*\*The national closing deadline that is listed is the INSTITUTIONAL deadline. The CAMPUS deadline applies to all sections of a student's application to the DDRA program.**

**It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the application is complete.**
